



The Magicshine MJ-808 LED Bike Headlight - User Guide

To Install

- Choose a rubber ring according to the size of your handlebar.
- Pull the ring onto the hook at the front of the light near the wire exit.
- Place the light on your bar at a location where the light will shine straight ahead (or slightly to the left when cycling on the road).
- Stretch the ring around the bar and over the hook at the rear.
- Choose a suitable location for the battery pack such as the handlebar stem, top tube (crossbar) or the opposite side of the bars.
- Unwind the cover of the pack to reach around the chosen location and use the Velcro to secure. If needed an additional strap/plastic tie can be used with the attached eyelets.

Charging

- Plug the charger into a standard UK outlet. The light on the charger should glow green.
- Attach the cord to the battery.
- The light on the charger will change from green to red when plugged into a battery needing charge, and then back to green when the battery is fully charged.
- A fully depleted battery will take around 4 hours to charge but you may leave it on longer as the battery is protected from overcharging.

Operation

- When first plugged in, the light will come on in high mode. Push the lighted button on the rear of the light through the following cycles; high, medium, low, strobe, SOS and off.
- The switch on the rear of the light will glow green through the first 75% of the battery charge and then switch in turn to blue, yellow and red, at which time you may wish to reduce the power setting or select a flashing mode to extend your riding time. The end of the charge is abrupt.

Caution

- The high power SSC P7 LED used in this light generates heat. The light will be warm during normal operation. The life of the LED is adversely affected by high temperatures. Air moving over the light as you ride is important to keep the light cool. It is suggested that if you are to be stationary for an extended period of time you switch the output to medium or low.

Care of your battery...

Lithium-ion batteries are commonly found on phones and laptops. They provide exceptional performance and will provide a long life to the user who follows these instructions. Failure to do so may invalidate the warranty.

A feature of this type of battery is that they will, over time, have reduced output times between charges. This is a standard feature for this type of battery and our 12 month warranty will not cover batteries that don't last quite as long as when originally supplied.

Do's and don'ts...

Do

- Re-charge the battery regularly. If not it may take a few attempts at re-charging to recover full capacity. If you use your light infrequently take the time to re-charge the battery every 3 months.
- Charge in a cool dry and area and never leave a charging battery unattended.
- Check the battery regularly for damage.
- Only use batteries supplied by Magicshine UK® on Magicshine products.

Don't

- Drop the battery and also, try to avoid any other serious impact which could cause a short circuit. In these circumstances take advice on disposal of the battery and buy a new one.
- Attempt to tamper with the battery and avoid any short circuits, reversing of polarity.
- Never keep the battery on permanent charge.
- Put the battery close to a fire or in water.
